- Update the [Immunization Record Update](#) with the SMD Health Unit if needed.
- Complete the [Transportation Opt-In Form](#), if applicable.
- Complete the Students with Unique Learning Needs (IEPs) Survey.  
(for *non-TLDSB* students only, complete and submit only if applicable)
- Review the [School Messenger Information](#). An account can be created once the new school year begins.
- Complete the above tasks by: **January 23, 2026**.
