IEP's for Exams:

Teachers and students will be having conversations about exam accommodations in early January. It is important to confirm with your son/daughter about their accommodations. **Students should be directly speaking with their teachers to build self-confidence and self-advocacy skills.** Teachers can only offer accommodations to students. It will be the student's decision, based on course, comfortability level, etc. if they take their accommodations. Having these conversations early help to ease anxiety and stress during the examination period.

Province Wide Testing:

EQAO Math testing is done in grade 9 in January. This year the dates are Jan. 15h-19th

Important Information:

- Students in applied or academic courses will write the test.
- Students will write the test over two days.
- Book 1 will be the written the first day and book 2 will be written the second day.
- A third day is booked for students who missed a day due to illness.
- Parents/Guardians will be mailed their students access to accommodations in December.
- Accommodations for provincial testing are different than regular accommodations in the classroom. Please call or email if you have any questions regarding your child's accommodations.
- All students will have a formula sheet provided in the EQAO test.
- Students will still have an exam in their math class. The EQAO Math test will be counted as part of their grade 9 mathematics mark.
