- You must have 6 Grade 12 University courses to apply in Ontario(Can be U or M coded courses)
 - ENG4U is a required mark
 - Average of your best 6 including compulsories: admission averages vary by school and program so do your research
 - Check program prerequisites before you apply
 - EINFO is a great resource
 - Have a “backup” program if you are applying to some competitive programs
 - You need an OUAC PIN # to apply to OUAC 101 - attain through guidance(late October)
 - Double check your application for errors and see Guidance if you have any concerns

2. Do I qualify for the program? (required courses, high school marks, limited enrollment, supplementary applications)
3. Is there an additional application process e.g. Portfolio or audition.
4. Can I receive financial assistance? (scholarships, bursaries, loans, automatic awards)
5. Where am I going to stay? (guaranteed accommodation, applying for residence, meal plan, off-campus options)
6. What else is there to do? (clubs, associations, societies, intramural sports, varsity sports, on-campus facilities)
7. What is the place like? (size, surroundings, student experience)
