- Jan. 13, 2022(at 11:59 pm): Application deadline to OUAC – online application
- Continue to check and apply for scholarships, grants and bursaries
- Continue to update your portfolio (if required for programs requiring a portfolio)
- Continue to attend post-secondary open house/s at Colleges/ Universities
- Jan 18 Full Disclosure for Quad 2 courses

February

- Feb. 1: Equal consideration deadline for college applications received at OCAS for programs starting in September
- Feb. 5: Earliest release of offers by colleges to applicants if the program did not do early offers.
- Feb 8: Sem 1 Final Grades upload to OCAS/OUAC
- Begin applying for residency (provided you have accepted an offer of admission and have a college or university student number)
- Continue to check and apply for scholarships, grants and bursaries

March

- Continue to check and apply for scholarships, grants and bursaries
- Check spam and emails for communication from Colleges/Universities
- Attend any scheduled Grad meetings
- Check OUAC/OCAS profile for accuracy

You may apply for OSAP as soon as you have submitted an OCAS or OUAC application.



April:

- April 24: OCAS,/OUAC final Quad 3 grades uploaded
- April 4 FULL DISCLOSURE (last drop date before it shows on transcript) for Quad 3 courses.
- Continue to check and apply for scholarships, grants and bursaries
- Continue to update your portfolio (for programs requiring a portfolio)
- Begin to research OSAP
- Attend Grad Meeting

May:

- May 1 - College Applicants must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission through OCAS. After this date, the college will determine the date the confirmation of acceptance is due
- May 27 – Expect to receive a response from an Ontario University by this date. Such a response will be one of the following: (1) an offer of admission (2) a refusal (3) a deferral pending the receipt of some specific additional information
- Attend Grad meetings
- Monitor OSAP status and application
- Monitor residence and tuition deposit due dates

June:

- June 13 Full Disclosure: Quad 4 marks
- June 1: The earliest date by which Ontario universities require a response to offer
- Monitor OSAP status and application
- Check OUAC/OCAS profile for accuracy
- Monitor residence and tuition deposit due dates
- Final Marks Uploaded to OUAC.OCAS on July 2
- **GRAD: TBA**

 - o Scholarships (www.scholarshipscanada.com, www.studentawards.com)
 - o Tuition
 - o Residency
 - o Other school Fees
- Check the Grade 12 Blog regularly

October:

- Full disclosure Oct 27 for Quad 1 courses
- Attend College/University virtual visits posted on Grade 12 Blog
- Ontario Uni Virtual Fair –**Sept 25 or Oct 26, 2021**
- **Check out the virtual events at ontatiocollegefair.ca**
- You may begin applying to Ontario college programs. Apply at www.ontariocolleges.ca. Click on the 'apply' icon, then click on 'create new account'
- ⇒ Cost: (credit card is recommended.) \$95 for 5 program choices
- Parents view the Post-Secondary Info Presentation

You may apply to University as soon as your Pin # arrives - sign this out in Guidance.

November:

- Get your OUAC PIN from your counsellor (usually November or Late Oct – Date TBA)
- Attend College/University virtual visits
- Continue to check and apply for scholarships, grants and bursaries
- Consider attending post-secondary virtual open house/s at Colleges/ Universities
- Final Quad 1 Marks uploaded to OCAS and OUAC
- Some college programs are now doing early offers in November

December:

- Consider applying to Ontario university undergraduate programs using your OUAC PIN: Apply at www.ouac.on.ca and click on the 'Undergraduate Application (OUAC 101) Current Ontario Secondary School Students' icon, and then click on the '101 online application'. Then you will click on the 'Login' icon.
- Cost: (credit card strongly recommended) \$150 for 3 program choices. Each additional program choice is \$50
- If applying to College or University outside of Ontario make sure you check their application due dates as it is often different than Ontario
