<b>Aramark Canada (Ltd.) Award for Food Industry Graduate</b>	Presented to a graduating student who is pursuing a career in the food services industry.
<b>Arts and Culture SHSM Award of Achievement</b>	To recognize a graduating student from the Arts and Culture SHSM.
<b>Canadian Federation of University Women - Muskoka Award</b>	Presented for academic potential to a female graduate who is pursuing further education and is in financial need.
<b>Canusa Award for College Chemistry</b>	To recognize the highest academic achievement of a graduating student in college level chemistry.
<b>Catholic Women's League of St. Mary's Award</b>	Presented to a female graduating student who will be continuing in a business program.
<b>Christine and Donald Lough Award</b>	Awarded to a student who has demonstrated a need and is going on to post-secondary.
<b>Construction SHSM Award of Achievement</b>	To recognize a graduating student from the Construction SHSM.
<b>Dorset Lions Club Bursary</b>	Presented to a graduating resident of Dorset who is pursuing a post-secondary education and has been active in community work.
<b>Dr. Catherine Zacal Chemistry Award</b>	To recognize the highest mark in chemistry for a graduating student continuing university studies in science.
<b>Edmond's GM Award for Automotive Technology</b>	Presented to a student who has shown above-average ability, progress and skill in the automotive technology program.
<b>Georgian College Dual Credit Award</b>	Presented to a graduating student who has demonstrated academic excellence in a dual credit.
<b>Governor General's Academic Medal</b>	Awarded to the student with the highest academic average based on all of their grade 11 and 12 courses
<b>Greg Munce Award for Literary Excellence</b>	To recognize a graduating student for their ability to think and write well.
<b>Greystone Engineering Award</b>	Awarded to a graduating student who intends to pursue civil engineering at university, with particular interest in construction, who has written a letter of intention, has been recommended by two tech teachers at HHS, and has shown a receipt of tuition paid.

<b>Harriet T. Weaver Bursary of the Lake of Bays Heritage Foundation</b>	Presented to a student in obvious financial need who has been accepted to college or university in a heritage-related discipline. (environmental studies, earth sciences, ecology, biology, zoology, botany, geography or history) Preference will be given to students from Lake of Bays. Cannot be related to any staff member of HHS, or any member of the Board of Trustees.
<b>Health and Wellness SHSM Award of Achievement</b>	To recognize a graduating student from the Health and Wellness SHSM.
<b>Horatio Alger Canadian Scholarship</b>	To recognize a graduating student with plans to enter university in the fall of 2020, who has demonstrated financial need, is involved in co-curricular and community service activities and displays integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity.
<b>Hospitality and Tourism SHSM Award of Achievement sponsored by Sysco (donated by Glen Campbell-Sysco)</b>	To recognize a graduating student from the Hospitality and Tourism SHSM.
<b>Huntsville &amp; District Agricultural Society Bursary</b>	For a graduating student who is going to further their academic studies in the field or related field of agriculture.
<b>Huntsville and Area Historical Society Award</b>	To recognize a graduating student who has displayed an interest in local heritage.
<b>Huntsville Community Choir Vocals Award</b>	Presented to a graduating student for excellence in vocal music.
<b>Huntsville District Memorial Hospital Auxiliary Award</b>	Presented to a student who is planning on pursuing post-secondary studies in health sciences.
<b>Huntsville Emergency Department Physicians Biology Award</b>	To recognize the highest academic achievement of a graduating student in biology.
<b>Huntsville High School Athletic Association True Sport Award</b>	Awarded at the athletic banquet but also at graduation to a student who has upheld the values of fair play, inclusion, hard work and striving for excellence.
<b>Huntsville High School Leadership in the Arts Award</b>	Presented to a graduate who exemplifies leadership in the arts. Sponsored by the HHS musical.
<b>Huntsville High School Student Council Leadership Award</b>	Presented to a graduating student who has made an outstanding contribution to the student parliament and to student life at Huntsville High School.
<b>Huntsville Legion Ladies Auxiliary Award</b>	Presented to a graduate who is pursuing education in the field of childcare or seniors.

<b>Hutcheson, Reynolds and Caswell Award for Mathematics</b>	To recognize outstanding achievement in mathematics.
<b>Ida May and Victor deRose Award</b>	For a graduating student who has worked hard for excellent academic achievement, is involved in student affairs, has made a contribution in some unique and special way to the life of the school and is in financial need.
<b>Independent Order of Oddfellows Award for Social Services</b>	To recognize a graduating male student in good standing who has shown commitment to helping others.
<b>JEH Thornton Memorial Award</b>	To honour the memory of the late JE Harry Thornton, a former principal of Huntsville High School, by assisting a graduating student who has been involved in the leadership of the school and is pursuing post-secondary education.
<b>John Longhurst Award for Excellence in Grade 12 Principles of Financial Accounting (The)</b>	Highest mark in Grade 12 Principles of Financial Accounting.
<b>Kareen Burns HFA Scholarship</b>	To recognize a graduate who will be continuing with art education and has demonstrated not only artistic talent and skill, but humanity in their approach to life.
<b>Kimberly-Clark Award for Apprenticeship/Skilled Trades</b>	Awarded to the graduating student with the highest academic standing who is pursuing post-secondary education in an apprenticeship or skilled trade and who completed their diploma in a four-year period.
<b>Kimberly-Clark Award for Business</b>	Awarded to the graduating student with the highest academic standing, who is pursuing post-secondary education in the field of business, and who completed their diploma in a four-year period.
<b>Kimberly-Clark Award for Engineering</b>	Awarded to the graduating student with the highest academic standing who is pursuing post-secondary education in the field of engineering, and who completed their diploma in a four-year period.
<b>The Kiwanis Club of Huntsville Muskoka Brenda Wainman Goulet Memorial Scholarship</b>	This scholarship is presented to a graduating student taking Visual Arts, who will continue in the arts at a post-secondary institution. The award recipient will be selected by the Visual Arts Department based on the student's body of work over their secondary school career, having been acknowledged as having a superior gift of expression and artistic flair.

<b>The Kiwanis Club of Huntsville Muskoka Volunteer Appreciation Scholarship</b>	This scholarship is presented annually to a graduating student, who has shown by example, an ongoing willingness to go above and beyond just volunteering in their school, but in their community and beyond. The award recipient will be selected by the Guidance Department based on the extent and variety of the student's body of volunteerism over their secondary school career.
<b>Krista Russell Memorial Award</b>	Presented to a student enrolled in a post-secondary Medical Laboratory Science Program who is not receiving another bursary, unless the candidate is the only graduating student enrolled in a medical laboratory program. If no student is enrolled in a medical laboratory program, the recipient can be enrolled in another medical diagnostic program (nursing students are not eligible).
<b>Lieutenant Governor's Community Volunteer Award</b>	Presented to a graduating student in recognition of a commitment to volunteer work.
<b>Louise Dickson Memorial Award for Mathematics</b>	To recognize overall achievement in grade 12 mathematics.
<b>Manufacturing SHSM Award of Achievement</b>	To recognize a graduating student from the Manufacturing SHSM.
<b>MBRP Engineering Bursary</b>	Awarded to the graduating student with the highest academic standing, who is pursuing post-secondary education in the field of engineering.
<b>McConnell Foundation Bursary</b>	The John McConnell and Margaret Ann Wilson McConnell Memorial Foundation Bursary is to assist graduating students with financial need to pursue a post secondary school education.
<b>McTavish/Stutt Award for Computer Science</b>	Presented to a student who has demonstrated superior skills and passion for computer programming.
<b>Me to We Graduation Award 2020</b>	To recognize a graduating student's dedication to character education and service learning.
<b>Muskoka Law Association Award</b>	Presented to a graduating student with outstanding achievement in Law.
<b>Muskoka Millwrighting and Machining Award given in Honour of Ann and Archie Wilson</b>	A student enrolled in the HHS Manufacturing & Welding program who exemplifies leadership, willingness to learn, good attendance, creativity and is going in to a college or trade related employment/apprenticeship.
<b>Myles Moynan Scholarship (The)</b>	To be awarded to a student who will study a trade after high school graduation who is currently enrolled in technical education studies at Huntsville High School. The student should demonstrate a need and a positive attitude.

<b>Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program Award</b>	To recognize a graduating student who made an outstanding contribution to the accelerated OYAP program and displayed a strong and exemplary performance in their co-op portion, a strong aptitude for their particular trade and a good work ethic. The student must be continuing their apprenticeship following secondary school.
<b>OPSEU Bursary</b>	Presented to a student who has demonstrated excellent achievement, a financial need and is pursuing post secondary education in a field represented by OPSEU members.
<b>OSSTF Proficiency Award</b>	Awarded to the three students with the highest academic standing in their graduating year.
<b>Principal's Award</b>	Presented to a graduating student who has demonstrated academic excellence, leadership in the school, and participation in extra-curricular activities.
<b>The Public Property Assessment Network Scholarship</b>	Presented to graduating students of strong character, who care deeply about their communities and furthering their own learning.

<b>Rotaract Scholarship</b>	Presented to a graduating student to use towards personal educational growth, be it an apprenticeship or post-secondary education. This person must have maintained at least a B average throughout their high school career, showing they are a hard worker. They should be community oriented and act on their beliefs, demonstrating their ability to make change. This person always supports their peers, indicating kindness. This person is humble and courteous, ensuring a positive environment. This person will not have received any other monetary awards at graduation. This is for the "B" student, that person you know can make a difference, that does their best and supports others.
<b>Royal Canadian Legion - Huntsville Branch Award</b>	To assist a graduate who has a relative that's a legion member or a war veteran and is continuing with a post secondary education.
<b>Specialist High Skills Major Award</b>	To recognize a graduating student who has demonstrated exemplary performance in all components of the SHSM program and is pursuing post-secondary training in a related field.
<b>Stacey Barden Award (The)</b>	Sponsored by the Pepler family and presented to a geography student with a balance of athletics, academics and community involvement.

<b>Stan Darling Environmental Education Award</b>	To honour the memory of Stan Darling, this award is given to a graduating student with high academic achievement who has demonstrated outstanding environmental commitment involving community service and leadership.
<b>Stephenson District Lions Club Keith Walton Award</b>	Presented to a graduating student for academic achievement at the college level who will be attending a post-secondary institution.
<b>Stepping Stone Award of Merit</b>	Presented to a student with high academic standing who has not received any other graduation awards.
<b>Stepping Stone Bursary sponsored by the Huntsville Men's Bridge Club</b>	Presented to a student with high academic standing who has not received any other graduation awards.
<b>The Huntsville Nature Club Bursary</b>	Presented to a deserving student continuing their post-secondary education in Environmental Studies; in particular focusing on creating and implementing responsible and innovative practices to protect and complement our environment.
<b>Unity Masonic Lodge Award for Social Science</b>	To recognize and assist a graduating student who has shown interest and achievement in the social sciences and plans on pursuing post-secondary education in this field.
