## Are You Hoping to Take Your IEP to Post Secondary With You?

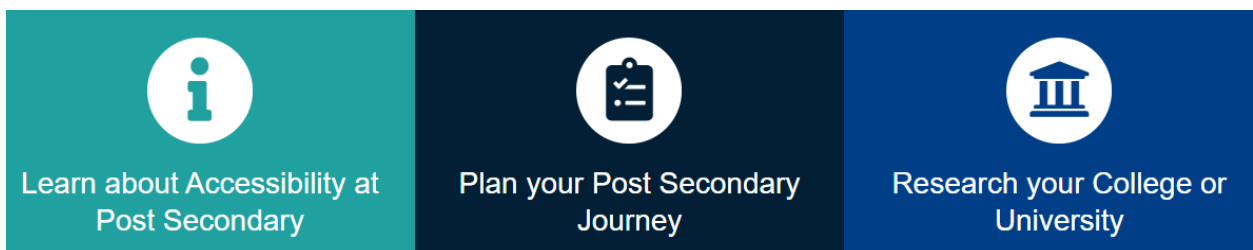
