## College to University Transfer Programs

- ON Transfer is a website dedicated to researching the many transfer programs in Ontario. ON Transfer
- Transfer Programs are increasingly popular! You typically graduate with 2 credentials: a diploma in a technical skill(College), and a Degree in a complementary area of study(University). For example a Diploma in Computer Programming to a Bachelor of Computer Science
- Generally transfer program take 4-5 years
